## HOUSE SYSTEM

*Transport:* The school owns deluxe type buses, plying on all the major routes of the city. A number of additional buses are being added to cover more areas.


*Canteen:* The school runs a contractual canteen that provides hygienic and wholesome eatables for the children at very competitive prices.


